



Rainy River Resources Ltd. is a Toronto-based junior exploration company that is focused on the development of our advance-stage gold exploration project situated in northwestern Ontario, approximately 50 kilometers northwest of Fort Frances.

We are currently seeking a **Senior Mine Engineer** to join our management team. The Company is focused on developing the existing resource and is completing the necessary engineering and environmental programs to advance the project through feasibility and permitting over the next 24 months. Exploration efforts continue to identify new areas of mineralization, both at depth and along strike.

The **Senior Mine Engineer** will report to the Vice President, Operations and have regular interface with senior project and company staff. The candidate will provide mine planning, scheduling, ore control, resource estimation, production reporting and construction design. The incumbent will lead the execution of the strategy for engineering, ensure maximization of operation efficiencies and profitability and ensure alignment with the company's overall strategy.

Qualifications:

A BSc in Mine Engineering and a Professional Engineering designation is required; an advanced degree is preferred. The successful candidates will have a minimum of 10 years of related work experience, including expertise with open pit engineering; additional underground experience would be beneficial. Knowledge of engineering techniques as they apply to ore body evaluation and mine operations is required along with an understanding of reserve estimation. Proficiency with mining software is needed.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Provide all mine planning activities including long and short range planning, mine scheduling, ore body modeling.
- Coordinate ore control project engineering, mine modeling, mine design, pit optimization and mine planning activities with overall mine plans and production schedules.
- Work closely with geology department to develop and maintain an effective ore control program. Develop and apply economic models to geologic model information.
- Formulate the annual operating and capital budgets for engineering, consistent with Rainy River's established financial guidelines and business planning process.
- Participate in equipment selection and economic evaluations and justifications. Develop mining stockpile and mineral production schedules.
- Update and maintain current property reserves. Oversee production reporting and reconciliation against mine plans.
- Work with mine management on contract administration including bid preparation, evaluation, and contractor selection. Participate in construction management including contractor supervision, design implementation and follow up.
- Provide engineering input when required in support of permit applications and other projects.

- Select, supervise and critique consultants who are retained to provide services for project.
- Direct engineering activities and assure implementation to provide for eventual orderly, safe and cost-effective mining.
- Maintain awareness of all applicable federal, provincial and local regulations and ensure compliance.
